#### Folkbildning- charasteristics



- It is always voluntary.
- Learning is a lifelong process.
- A clear mission to strengthen democracy and active citizenchip.
- Freedom of syllabus. Own study/workingplans.
- Close relation to society and social movements.

The key insight is that everyone, regardless of age, gender or background, has the potential for development on the basis of their own unique skills and proficiencies.







- Study circle started in the beginning of 20th century:
- For exchange of knowledge to disadvantaged groups.
- To achieve social changes.
- Giving people knowledge and the ability to make their voice heard.
- To strengthen and develop democracy.

### **Non-formal adult education**



- 10 study associations in Sweden
- Most of the major movements work in partnership with a study association.
- A part of civil society
- Organise cultural programmes and lectures
- The study circle is the cornerstone of folkbildning.
- Is recognised by all political parties
- It is run separately from the state, but financed by public funds.



- Strengthen and develop democracy.
- Make it possible for people to influence their life situation and create participative involvement in societal development.
- Bridge educational gaps and raise the level of education and cultural awareness in society.
- Broaden the interest for and increase participation in cultural life.

- SV formally founded in 1967.
- SV is an association for education, training and culture for adults.
- For private citizens and associations/organisations.
- Equal rights for all people.
- Diversity.
- Meeting places in study circels and cultural arrangements.
- Everyone is welcome.
- Over 300 offices around in Sweden.
